

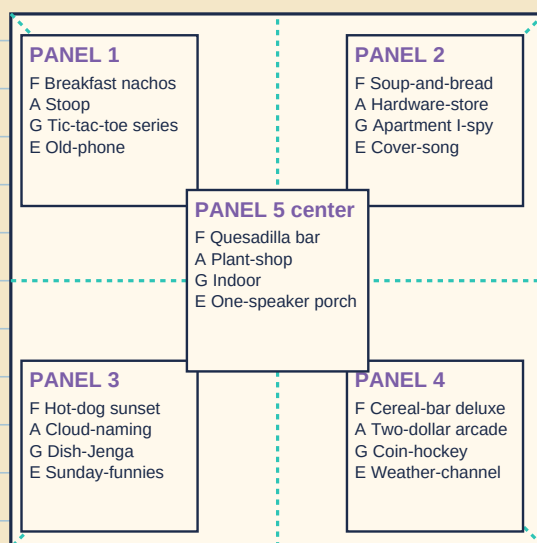
Folded Fate

Passing Notes · a date-night game

You don't have to agree on a plan. Just agree to play.

2 players · 2–4 min · a sheet

Fold the four corners in. Pass the note. Partner picks a packet. That's tonight.



1 top-left · 2 top-right · 3 bottom-left · 4 bottom-right · 5 center

How to play

How you pick

1. Pick Zero Thought (printed defaults), Make It Ours (write over any line), or Blank Slate (use the blank sheet).
2. You need exactly five live options in every category or you do not start.
3. On Make It Ours or Blank Slate you may secretly write one change on a corner, then fold. Optional tear-tab to seal it.
4. Fold the four corners in. Five packets remain: four corners + center.
5. Pass the note. Partner picks one packet (point, or say 1–5, or tear one corner).
6. Unfold. That panel is tonight.

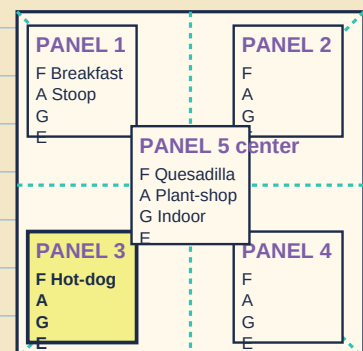
Panel map (print this block verbatim)

Panel i is option i. Panel 1 = first option in each list. Panel 2 = second. Panel 3 = third. Panel 4 = fourth. Panel 5 = center = fifth. All five can win.

Worked pick (locked oracle)

panel = 3 (bottom-left)
Food 1 Breakfast nachos
Food 2 Soup-and-bread night
Food 3 Hot-dog sunset ← winner
Food 4 Cereal-bar deluxe
Food 5 Quesadilla bar

Digital must match this pick. Same options + same panel = same four winners.

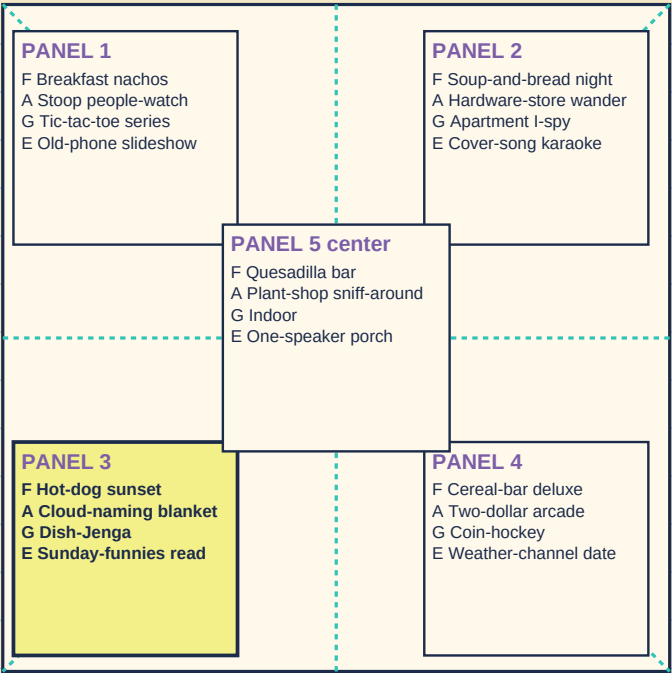
