Passing Notes · a date-night game

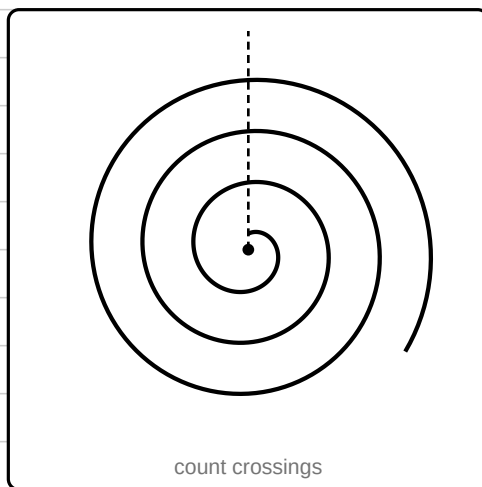
You don't have to agree on a plan. Just agree to play.

2 players · 2–4 min · a pen



Draw a spiral. Count the rings. Cross out every Nth option.

Four survivors. That's tonight.

How to play

How you get N

1. Pick Zero Thought (printed defaults), Make It Ours (write over any line), or Blank Slate (use the blank sheet).
2. Draw a spiral on the pad. Start near the center.
3. Count how many times your line crosses the spoke (the printed line from the center dot to the top). That number is N. N must be 2 through 20.
4. If you cannot count the crossings, write N yourself. Do not guess for the pad.
5. You need exactly five live options in every category or you do not start.

How you cross out (QA §1.1 — print this block verbatim)

Start at the first option (index 0). Count N live options (the start position is count 1). Cross out that option. Continue from the next live option. Repeat until one live option remains.

Run independently in each category with the same N. Direction is clockwise / down the list.

N must be 2–20. If you counted 1, add a loop or count again. Do not write 2.

Worked count (locked oracle)

L = taco, ramen, pizza, sushi

N = 3

start = taco (index 0)

count-1 = taco, count-2 = ramen, count-3 = pizza → pizza out

live = taco, ramen, sushi; resume at sushi

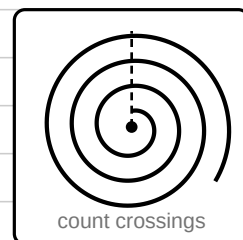
count-1 = sushi, count-2 = taco, count-3 = ramen → ramen out

live = taco, sushi; resume at sushi

count-1 = sushi, count-2 = taco, count-3 = sushi → sushi out

winner = taco

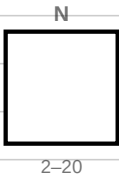
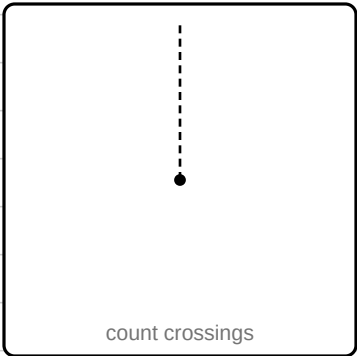
Digital must match this trace. Same options + same N = same four winners and the same elimination order.
